Preschooler (ages 4–5)

- Pick up/ put away toys
 - Unload the dishwasher
 - Dust with feather duster/microfiber rag
 - Swiffer the floor
 - Put clothes in the dirty clothes hamper
 - Collect dirty clothes
 - Help move clothes (washer to dryer)
 - Put clothes away
 - Match socks
 - Fold dish towels, small laundry items
 - Make bed
 - Wipe cabinets

Early Elementary (ages 6–8)

- All previous chores
- Meal prep (wash produce, find ingredients, simple cutting)
- Wipe bathroom sinks, counters, toilets
- Hang out laundry
- Sweep
- Vacuum
- Collect garbage
- Get mail
- Fold/hang laundry
- Clean microwave
- Rake leaves
- Help wash car

- Wipe baseboards (soapy water)
 - Load the dishwasher
 - Vacuum couch/ chairs/ cushions
 - Empty trash
 - Take out recycling
 - Set/clear table
 - Wash dishes (with supervision)
 - Wipe out bathroom sinks
 - Water indoor plants
 - Feed pets
 - Help clean up own messes
 - Put away groceries

Elementary (ages 9–11)

- All previous chores
- Make simple meals
- Take garbage/ recycling to the curb
- Wash/ dry clothes
- Clean bathroom
- Mop floors
- Wash dishes
- Load/unload dishwasher
- Pack lunches
- Clean refrigerator
- Supervise siblings
- Clean windows
